PLACING OF PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD IDENTIFYING MARKS ON PCG  
BUILDINGS / VESSELS / AIRCRAFT

1. **GENERAL:**

This publication prescribes the paint colors and the appropriate painting procedure to be undertaken on placing of PCG identifying marks.

2. **SCOPE:**

This circular shall apply to all PCG headquarters, stations, detachments, units, afloat/ashore, aircraft, light stations and coast guard auxiliary offices.

3. **PLACEMENT:**

- a. PCG stripe (international orange, white and blue) and logo with words "PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD" shall be painted in a fixed board and hang in front of all PCG district headquarters, stations, detachments, light stations and unit buildings where can be best seen. The dimension of each letter of identifying marks is sixteen (16) centimeters high, ten (10) centimeters width and three (3) centimeters thick, color black. The dimension of the orange stripe is forty five (45) centimeters high and thirty (30) centimeters thick. The white and blue stripes are forty five centimeters high and ten (10) centimeters thick each and the PCG logo shall be painted in the center of the orange stripe with a diameter of twenty four (24) centimeters (Annex A).
- b. PCG stripe and logo with words "PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD" shall be painted in the port and starboard side of all auxiliary, SAR and patrol vessels to include small and fast craft. In addition, SAR vessels shall be painted with words "SEARCH AND RESCUE" in the superstructure port and starboard side.
- c. The following guidelines in painting of Philippine Coast Guard identifying marks to PCG vessels, small craft and aircraft should be closely adhered to:

1. For the Auxillary Tender (AE), the words "PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD" shall be painted in the port and starboard of the superstructure. The letters should be solid dark blue and with dimensions of thirty five (35) centimeters high and six (6) centimeters thick. PCG stripe with logo shall be placed after the bow number painted parallel to the ship's bow from the waterline up to the gunwale with dimensions of ninety (90) centimeters thick for the orange stripe and thirty (30) centimeters thick each for the white and blue stripes. The PCG logo shall be seventy (70) centimeters in diameter painted in the center of orange stripe align with the bow number. Bow number is colored white. (Annex B)
2. The words "PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD" shall be painted horizontally at the center of the freeboard of the Search and Rescue Ships, color white, with dimensions of thirty five (35) centimeters high and six (6) centimeters thick for each letter. The PCG stripe with logo shall be placed after the bow number, painted parallel to the ship's bow from the water line up to the gunwale with dimensions of fifty two (52) centimeters thick for the orange stripe and seventeen point five (17.5) centimeters thick each for white and blue stripes. The PCG logo shall be forty two (42) centimeters in diameter painted in the center of orange stripe align with the bow number. The words "SEARCH AND RESCUE" shall be painted at the superstructure port and starboard side, color dark blue, with dimensions of twenty five (25) centimeters high and five (5) centimeters thick for each letter. (Annex C)
3. For the Patrol Gunboat (PG), the words "PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD", shall be painted at the superstructure port and starboard side color dark blue and with dimensions of twenty five (25) centimeters high and five (5) centimeters thick for each letter. The PCG stripe with logo shall be placed after the bow number painted parallel to the ship's bow from the waterline up to the gunwale with dimensions of thirty seven point five (37.5) centimeters thick for the orange stripe and twelve point five (12.5) centimeters thick each for white and blue stripes. The PCG logo shall be twenty seven point five (27.5) centimeters in diameter painted in the center of orange stripe align with the bow number. Bow number is colored white. (Annex D)
4. For the Fast Patrol Craft and Patrol Boat, the words "PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD" shall be painted at the superstructure port and starboard side, color dark blue with dimensions of fifteen (15) centimeters high and three point five (3.5) centimeters thick for each letter. The PCG stripe shall be placed after the bow number painted parallel to the ship's bow from the waterline up to the gunwale with dimensions of thirty (30) centimeters thick each for the orange stripe and ten (10) centimeters thick each for the white and blue stripes. PCG logo shall be twenty three (23) centimeters in diameter, painted in the center of the orange stripe align with the bow number. Bow number is colored white. (Annex E)

(body part) port and starboard side and underwing starboard side for fixed wing. For the helicopters, it shall be painted on port and starboard side of the tailboom and under the fuselage. PCG stripe with logo shall be placed on the forward section and on the vertical stabilizer of the aircraft. The size and dimensions of markings and letters will be in proportionate with the size of the aircraft.

**4. MISCELLANEOUS:**

- a. Epoxy and reflecting paints will be utilized for this purpose.
- b. All PCG vessel and small craft shall be painted dark blue for the hull and international orange for the superstructure. All railing and stanchions will be painted white.
- c. For the purpose of uniformity, the PCG identifying marks to be hanged in front of the PCG districts headquarters, stations, detachment, light stations and units building shall be painted in a fixed board made up of plane G.I. sheet supported by frames made of lumber.
- d. The letter and numerical type to be used in marking vessels/craft should be the block type as illustrated in Annex F.
- e. The international orange shall be used for the PCG orange stripe and superstructure of PCG vessel and small craft.

**5. TASK:**

The Commanders Coast Guard Support Facility and Coast Guard Operating Forces and the District Commanders shall be responsible for the strict implementation of this Circular.

**6. RECISSION:**


All circulars in conflict with the above provisions are hereby rescinded.

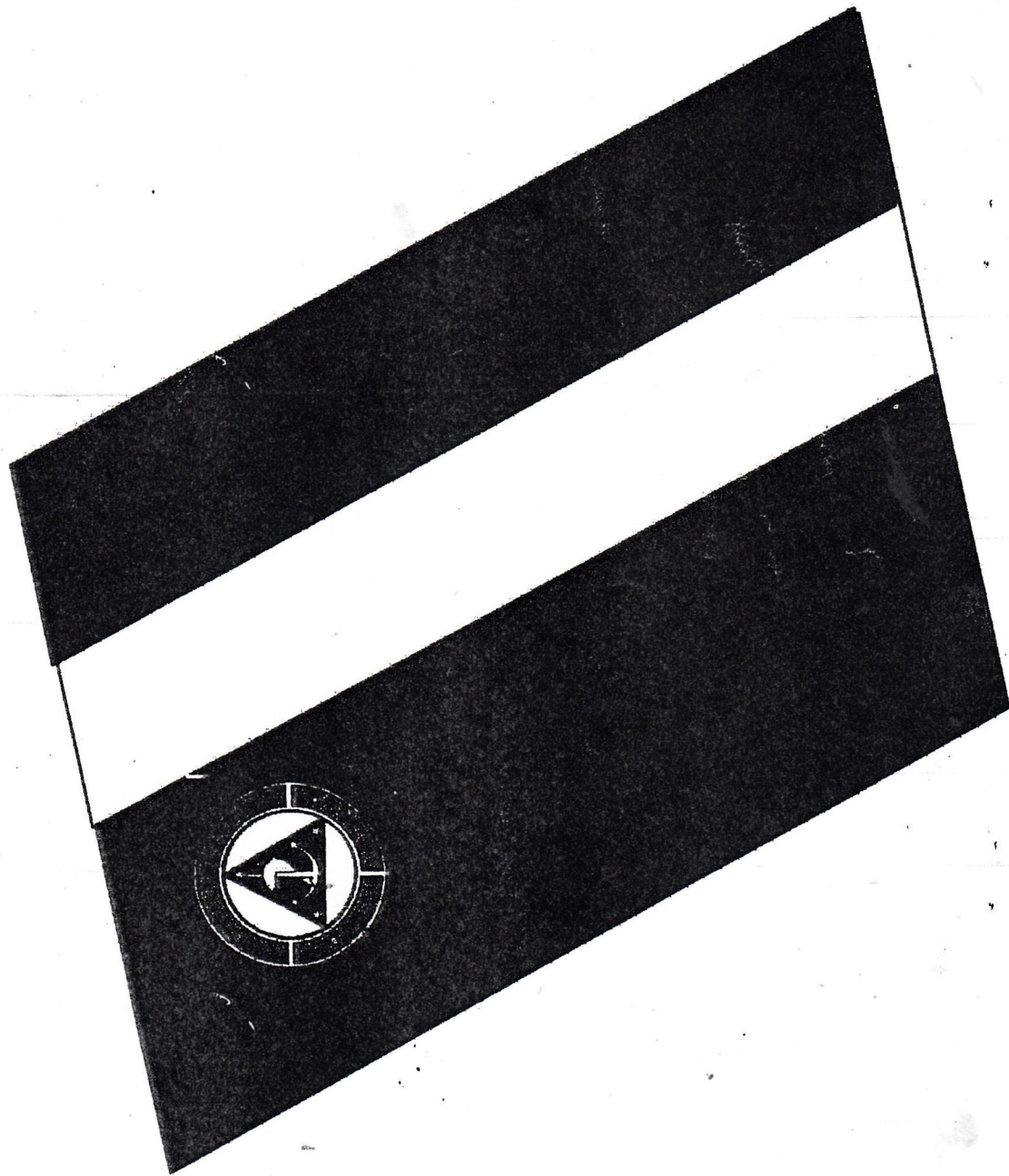

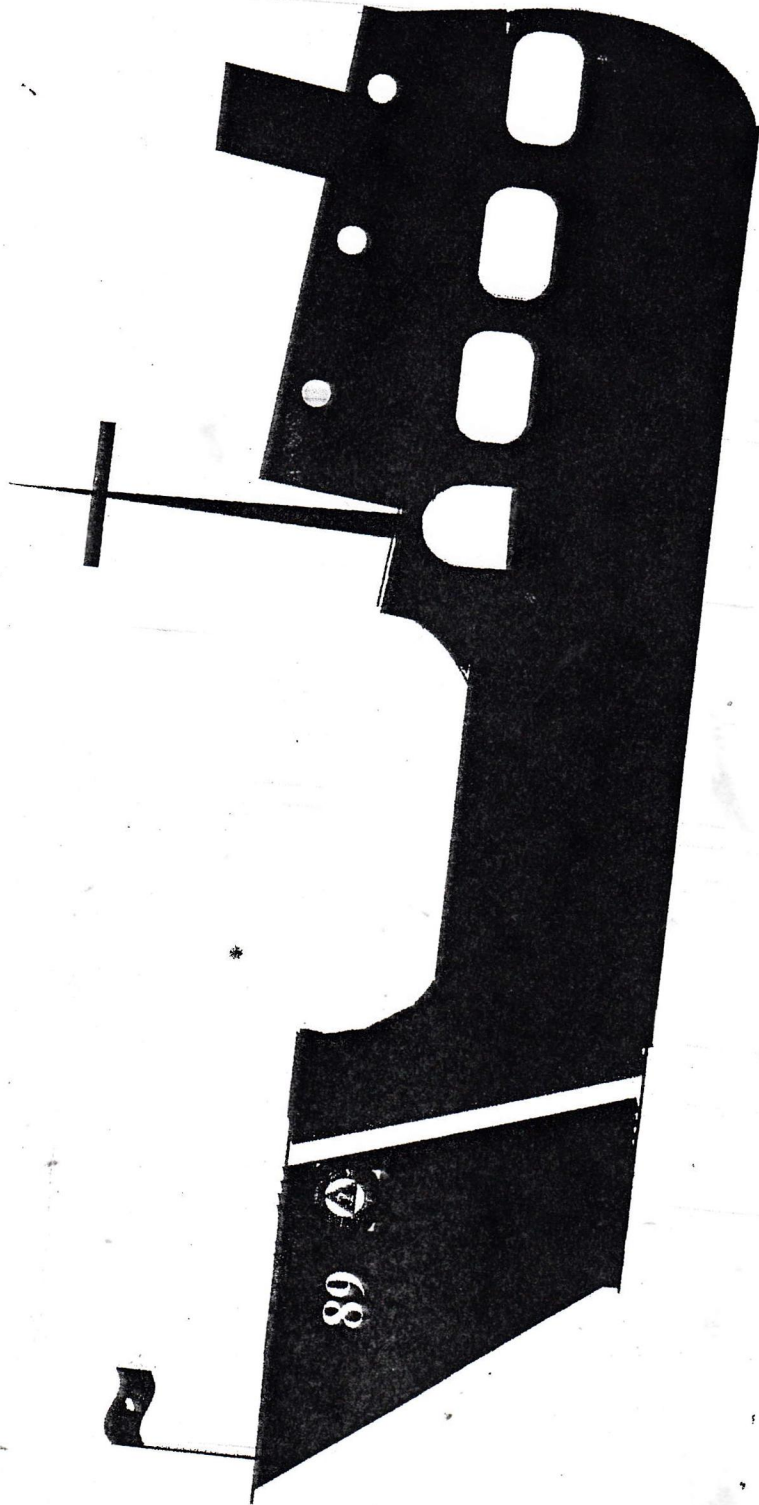

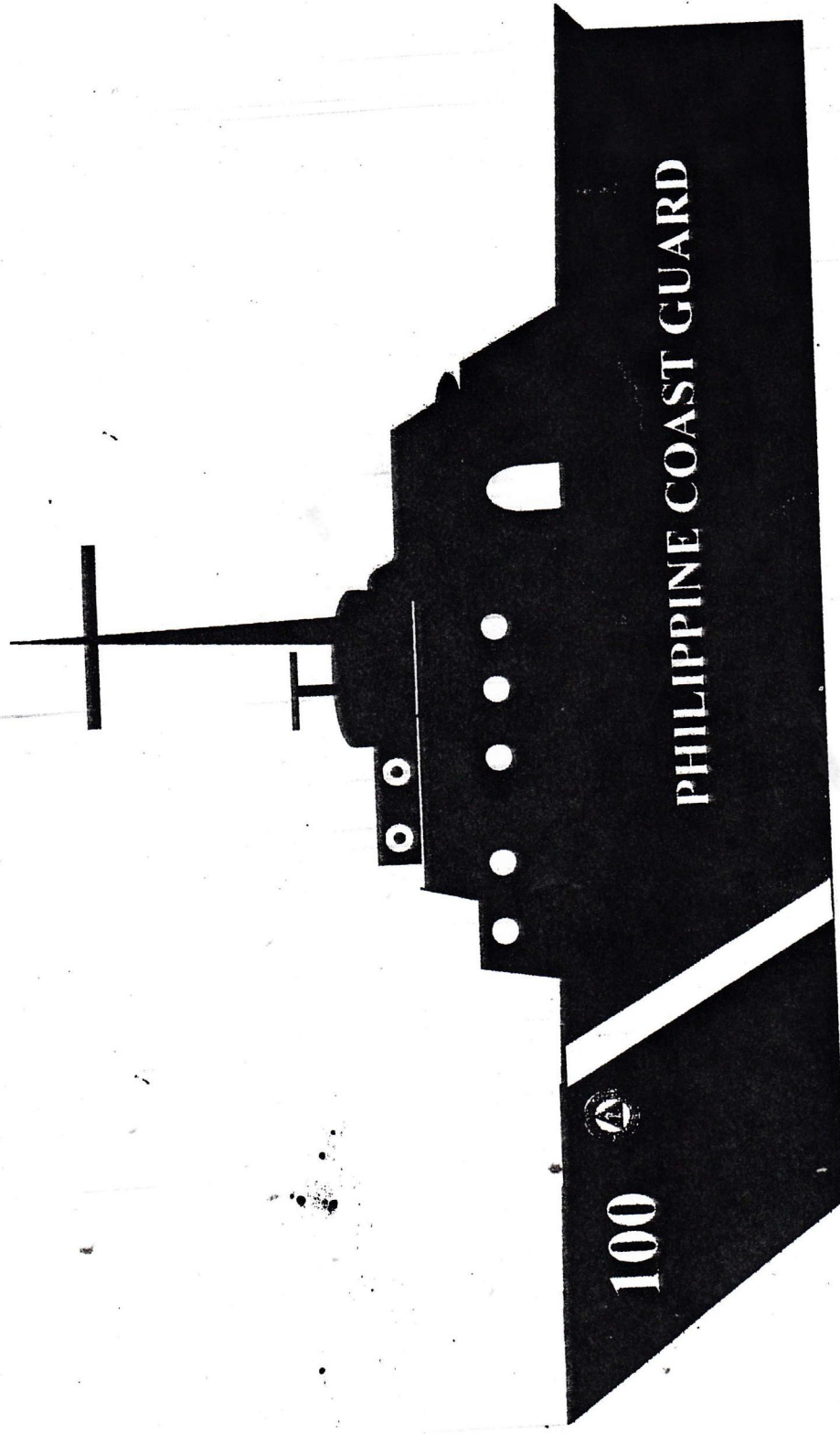

DETACHMENTS, LIGHTHOUSES**



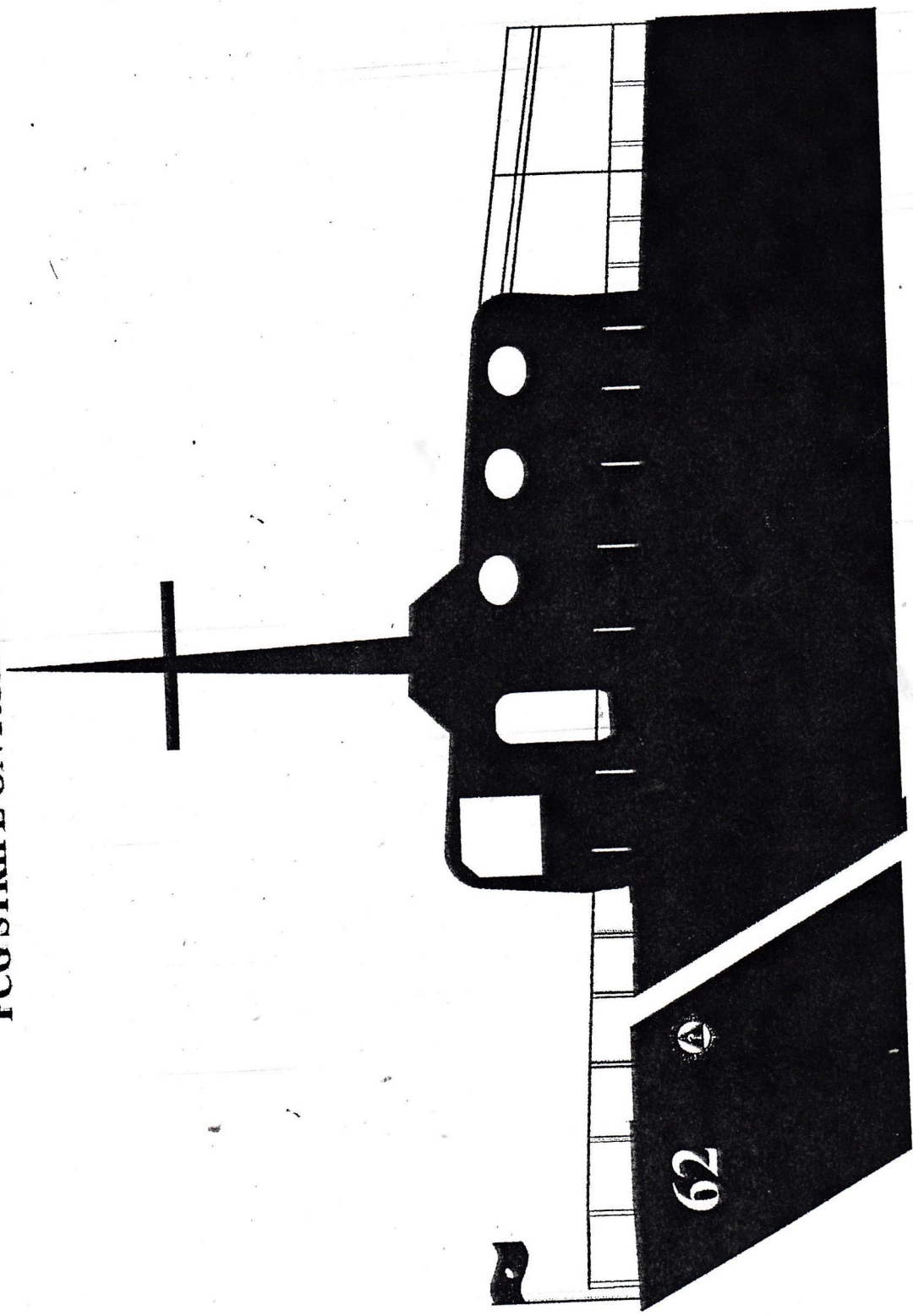
**Annex B: VESSEL COLOR SCHEME AND  
PCG STRIPE ON AUXILIARY TENDER (AE) VESSEL**



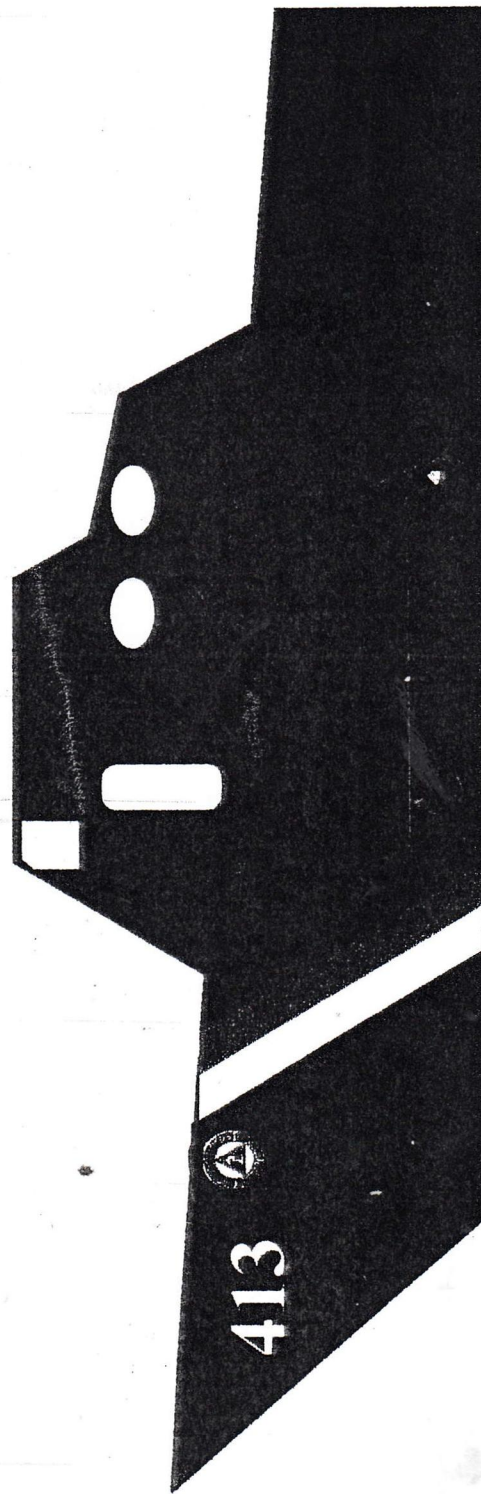
**Annex C: VESSEL COLOR SCHEME AND
